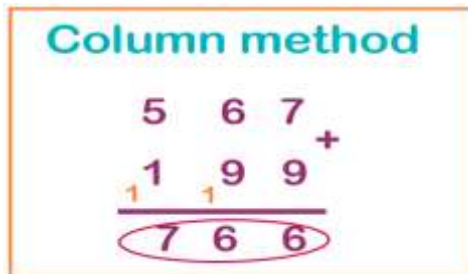


### English:

### Maths:

This involved the use of carrying from the ones value to the tens value and from the tens value to the hundreds.
