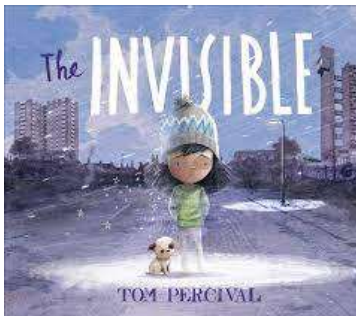




Welcome back, hope that you all had a lovely half term.

**The Bishop of Southwark's Lent Call 2022**

As part of our spring term Love Project, we are once again supporting the Southwark Diocese Lent Call.
