



## Year 2 Homework Letter, Friday 25th February 2022

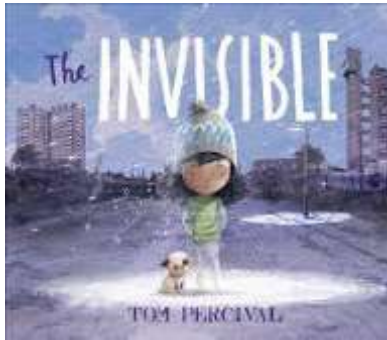
I hope you had a lovely half term break.



### English
