This week Year 3 started a new book called 'The Tear Thief' by Carol Ann Duffy. We began creating questions about the book using the limited information available from the pictures. As a class we also looked at the authors use of verbs, looking at how they added detail to the text as well as informed us of the tense it is written in. Later on in the week the children focused again on Carol Ann Duffy's use of metaphors and similes to again add another layer of flair to the story.

Maths:

This week we moved onto multiplication. We began the week by multiplying numbers by 10 looking at rules on how to do this effectively. We later moved onto learning two new methods for multiplication.
