



## Year 4 Homework letter - Friday 4th February 2022

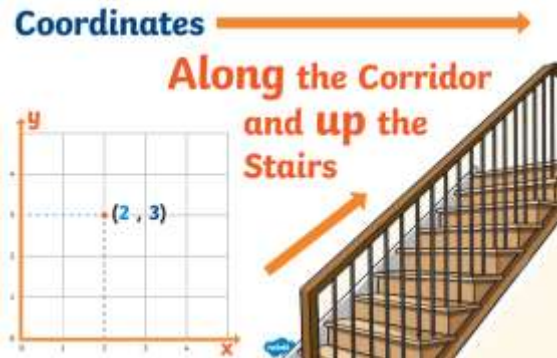
### English

### Maths

During Maths this week we have been working on coordinates. The children can now plot points on a grid and have started to translate shapes on a graph using simple instructions.
