





Year 4 Homework letter - Friday 28th January 2022

English

This week in English we have covered quite a few key Year 4 points. We have explored how the author, C.S Lewis, uses humour in the story to break tense moments. As a class we re-told the story orally. We also inferred a conversation between Aslan and Edmund that the author did not write. We asked the children, based on the story to think about what might have been said between these two characters. Finally as a group we highlighted the key parts within the story and acted these out in groups to show what had happened so far.

Maths

During Maths this week we have been working on Geometry. In a busy week we have triangles, angles and quadrilaterals. This is the first time the children have covered this and we will continue to revise it.
