### Maths


In Maths this week we have been revising how a shape transforms in the four quadrants. A **transformation** is a way of changing the size or position of a shape. There are different kinds of transformations:

1-**Rotation** is when the shape is turned (or rotated) around a point.

2-**Reflection** is when a shape is reflected in a mirror line.

3-**Translation** is when a shape is moved a certain distance from its original position.

### English

In English, the children finished reading the second part of 'Beowulf'. The fiend, Grendel, has been defeated, his arm and claw hanging in the rafters of Heorot as proof and as a trophy. Beowulf is being celebrated as the hero he is. However, another monster- Grendel's mother- stalks the Thanes of Denmark, and Beowulf's skills are about to be tested again. The children planned an informal letter from Beowulf to his father recounting his battle with Grendel and Grendel's mother.

In Grammar this week we have been revising verb tenses. There are three basic tenses: present, past, and future. Each has a perfect form, indicating a completed action; each has a progressive form, indicating an ongoing action; and each has a perfect progressive form, indicating the ongoing action will be completed at some definite time.

To support Loveworks, this term we are running our 'A Tin A Week' project again. We are asking that each family bring a tin of food into school each week. Tins will be collected and will be taken to Loveworks. Items which are particularly needed include: tins of meat, cereals, jam, pasta sauce, tins of fruit, tins of vegetables, coffee, small bags of sugar and rice.

### Homework

This week, our homework is spellings, a sheet of Maths to revise our learning about transformation of shape, a short reading comprehension and a grammar revision worksheet.
