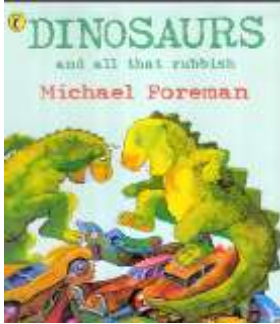




**English**
