English

This week we have started a new book 'The Tadpole's Promise'. This book gives us the opportunity to make cross-curricular links to the work we have done in Science. So far this week we have thought about things that change and used conjunctions to explain why. Then we used time adverbials: first, next, then and finally to describe what happens to a caterpillar and a tadpole during their life-cycle.

Maths

This week in Maths our focus has been on fractions. We have looked at the following areas: finding $\frac{1}{2}$ of a number, $\frac{1}{4}$ of a number, $\frac{1}{3}$ of a number and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a number. We also looked at how to find the whole of a number when only half is known. To help us with our learning on fractions we used the division method.

Method: find $\frac{1}{3}$ of 15.

$$15 \div 3 = 5$$
