English:

This week in English we have continued our book 'Leon and the Place Between'. The children have begun to write their own versions using the skills learnt so far in this unit of work. The children have been using fronted adverbials, noun phrases, adverbs, speech and alliteration to write their own versions of their stories using themselves as the main character.

Maths:

This week we began to extend our learning on measurement and have been looking at finding the perimeter of regular shapes. We began by identifying the edges of squares and rectangles and measuring their edges. We then used our addition skills to add the length of each side together to work out their perimeter. To end the week we learnt how to calculate the perimeter of irregular shapes.
