Easter Gardens

They will then be displayed in the hall from Tuesday 29th until Thursday 31st March where there will be an opportunity for each class to visit the hall to look at the different creations. The gardens will be taken over to St Peter and St Paul's Church on Friday 1st April where they will be on display over the Easter period.
