IMPORTANT INFORMATION, WHEN BOOKING THE DISCO, PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU CHOOSE EITHER KS1 OR KS2. This allows us to cater for each Disco separately.

This is a NEON disco, so where possible, please ask your children to wear the appropriate colour clothes to have maximum impact. Most white clothes will glow under a black light and so will most neon-coloured clothes. There are also tons of shirts that have designs on them that will glow. These are usually labelled as glow-in-the-dark, so they are easy to spot.

There will be sweets, neon face paint and glow sticks for sale, and so please make sure your children bring some money with them.

The KS1 disco will run from 4.00 - 5.00pm.

We would ask that you please collect your child/children from the playground as you do at the end of each school day. The children will line up in classes and a dismissal register will be taken. Please do let the adult who is dismissing the children know that you have your child if you have not made eye contact.

The KS2 disco will run from 5.30 - 6.30pm.

The slightly changed, later start time is to avoid a bottleneck of traffic in the village with children from KS1 being dismissed and the next set of KS2 children arriving.

For the KS2 disco, please collect your child/children from the playground as you do at the end of each school day. The children will line up in classes and a dismissal register will be taken. Please do let the adult who is dismissing the children know that you have your child if you have not made eye contact.

Year Six children who usually walk home from school alone **do not** have permission to walk home alone. Please arrange for them to be picked up. If you wish for them to walk home, please email info@nutfield.surrey.sch.uk

One final note: Please could all parents/carers arriving by car be considerate of local residents when choosing where to park. We would be grateful if you could avoid parking in front of driveways etc. You are also aware of course that there will be lots of children arriving and leaving both discos, so please drive slowly and carefully around the school entrances and in Mid Street. Thank you for helping us with this. The safety of the children and our relationships with our neighbours is very important.
