All the children thoroughly enjoyed the trip to RHS Wisley last week and were beautifully behaved.

English

This week we have continued using the book 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers. We looked at the verbs from the first part of the story - e.g. ignored, helped etc. and discussed that these verbs were all in the past tense because they had already happened.

We identified the ending of these verbs and thought about how to turn these verbs into the present tense by removing the ed ending, e.g. help, ignore, ask.

We also wrote instructions for 'How to help someone who is lost'
