



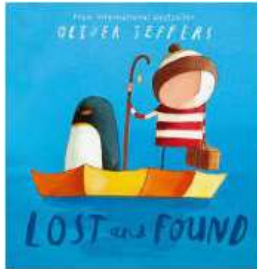
## Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2022



I hope you all had a happy and restful break. The Summer newsletter detailing our learning and events for this term is now on the school website.

### English

This term we have begun reading a new book in English - 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers.



We have learnt how to write an expanded noun phrase about the lost penguin and some other friends that were lost. An expanded noun phrase is an extended description comprising of two adjectives and a noun, for example, the lost penguin with sad, dark eyes. We have also learnt about adverbs - words that describe a verb (a doing word) eg. beautifully and carefully. Now we are learning about penguins and we will be writing a short information text (non-chronological report) about them and their home, Antarctica.

### Homework

Reading books will continue to be changed 3 times a week on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Please read with your child every evening if you are able for 10-15 minutes.

Spellings- please get your child to practise the spellings that are in their homework

### Victorian day

We are going to do hold a Year One Victorian day in school on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May. Your child will have the opportunity to come to school dressed as a Victorian and to participate in a range of activities linked to this topic. Please ask if you have any questions.

We have also learnt about place value. Place value is the value of each digit depending on its place in the number, for example, the 1 in 41 is worth one unit and the 4 is worth 40 (4 tens).
