English:

This week Year 3 continued to look at our new book 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner. The Children have been focusing on up-levelling their writing by using fronted adverbials linked to time to structure their writing. We then started to focus on the adjectives and verbs we use within our work and began to think of more powerful words to use instead that could give our writing as extra oomph!

Maths:
