English:

Year 3 continued to look at our new book 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner. This week the children started to write up their innovated sequel following the next character who discovered the mysterious camera. At the end of the week the children began to edit and check their work. Making sure it included: fronted adverbials, noun phrases, use of prepositions and powerful verbs.

Maths:

This week, we have recapped division using the formal multiplication method to divide a two digit or a three digit number by a 1 digit number. The children then began to challenge themselves by turning word problems into division sentences to solve.
