Business Enterprise

We have launched our business enterprise. Our class has been divided into five teams. The children will work together during the enterprise lessons and in running their businesses. They came up with great names for their teams. The children understand what enterprise means and they are able to describe entrepreneurial skills. After rating themselves across a number of different skills, they allocated the best person on their team for each role. These roles are:

- **Managing Director:** this person is responsible for making key decisions about the business.
- **Marketing Manager:** marketing is all about communicating your idea or product to your customers.
- **Production Manager:** this person's job is to make the product or organise the activity.
- **Finance Manager:** this person is responsible for overseeing all of the money.
- **Sales Manager:** this person is all about sales – selling as much as possible at the right price.

They will create a product; calculate the cost and profit; produce the product; advertise it and sell it. The profits will be used for the Year 6 Party.
