Then we wrote our own version of the story using ideas from our group work and a vocabulary list. This term we are focusing on our handwriting and making sure we ALWAYS have a capital letter and a full stop. As the story is about music, we used different musical instruments to learn about the present and past progressive tense eg. Strumming, playing and shaking. We also learnt the rule for adding the suffix 'ing' to these verbs. We had lots of fun!



Water bottles, sun hats and waterproofs

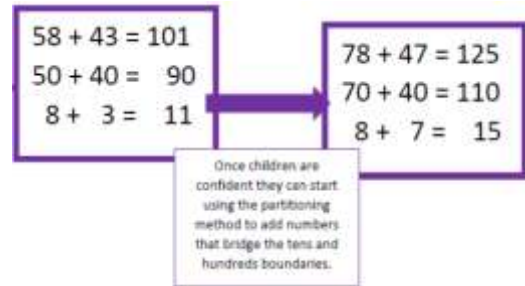
