This week we have been researching an animal of choice. We used iPads to find out about an animal, made notes which we then used to write a short piece of information about their animal with illustrations. Next week are starting a new book called 'Rosie Revere Engineer'.

Maths

This week we are recalling what we know about measure, shape and fractions.

- 2D and 3D shapes and their properties for instance - a sphere has 1 face
- the children need to be able to tell the time - o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to (and to the nearest 5 minutes if they can!)
- we can find a half and a quarter - this week we have been refining finding a third and three quarters

This week's homework will be linked to our learning in Maths and will be on MyMaths. There are 3 tasks but the children do not need to complete all 3, but if they can, great!

Thanks to the children's hard work this year we now have lettuce, spinach, carrots and strawberries growing in the kitchen garden. Very exciting!
