



Year 3 Homework letter - Friday 10.06.2022



Welcome back! I do hope you all had a restful half term. It's been great to hear all the exciting activities the children got up to during the time away. As we enter the final term of Year 3, please do continue to support the children with their homework as this will give them a great foundation towards the next academic year.

English:

This week in English we had a grammar focus. We looked at spelling rules for turning verbs from their simple present into their past tense and progressive forms. We also looked at when and how to use these forms correctly. Later on in the week we looked at using apostrophes for possession and inverted commas for speech.

Maths:

This week, we have recapped division using the formal multiplication method to divide a two digit or a three digit number by a 1 digit number. The children then began to challenge themselves by using this knowledge to solve fractions questions.

To solve this the children need to divide their quantity by the denominator of the fraction:

$$\frac{2}{5} \text{ of } 65 = 26$$
$$\begin{array}{r} 13 \\ 5 \overline{) 65} \\ \underline{5} \\ 15 \\ \underline{15} \\ 0 \end{array}$$

Then they need to multiply their answer by the numerator of the fraction to find the full answer. To do this they will need to use the formal method for multiplication.

$$\begin{array}{r} 13 \\ 2 \times \\ \hline 6 \quad (2 \times 3) \\ 20 \quad (10 \times 2) \\ \hline 26 \end{array}$$
