

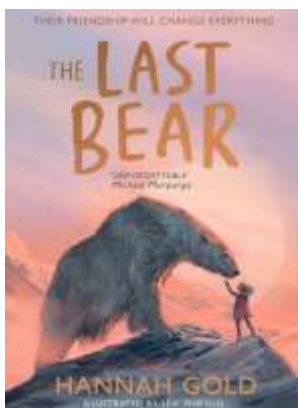


Year 5 Homework letter - Friday 10th June 2022

English

This week we have started our new book 'The Last Bear' by Hannah Gold. We have made predictions, read the first few chapters and written diary entries as the main character this week. Maths

We have been revising multiplication and division this week. All children should be able to use the formal methods:

124 x 26 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} \begin{array}{cc} 1 & 2 \\ 1 & 2 & 4 \\ \times & 2 & 6 \\ \hline 7 & 4 & 4 \\ 2 & 4 & 8 & 0 \\ \hline 3 & 2 & 2 & 4 \\ 1 & 1 & & \end{array} \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Answer: 3224

496 ÷ 11 becomes

$$\begin{array}{r} 45 \text{ r } 1 \\ 11 \overline{) 496} \\ \underline{44} \\ 56 \\ \underline{55} \\ 1 \end{array}$$

Answer: 45 $\frac{1}{11}$
