## Maths


The children learnt how to and construct pie charts. Pie charts are used in data handling and are circular charts divided up into segments that each represent a value. To draw a pie chart, we need to represent each part of the data as a proportion of 360, because there are 360 degrees in a círcle.

Angle formula:

360 degrees/total frequency X each frequency= angles of the segment.


