### Maths

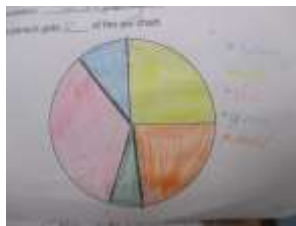
The children learnt how to and construct pie charts. Pie charts are used in data handling and are circular charts divided up into segments that each represent a value. To draw a pie chart, we need to represent each part of the data as a proportion of 360, because there are 360 degrees in a circle.

Angle formula:

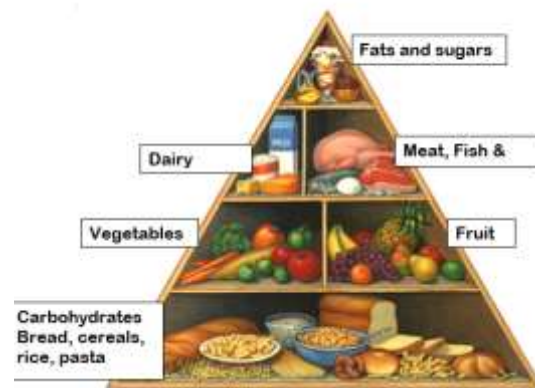
$360 \text{ degrees} / \text{total frequency} \times \text{each frequency} = \text{angles of the segment.}$
