



Year R Homework Letter Friday 6th May 2022



Our learning this week -

We have continued to learn about Space this week and we have been learning about all of the different planets in our solar system. We have also been listening to fun songs that explain features of the different planets. In PE, we have been practicing for Sports Day. The children loved participating in races and worked well in teams.

Literacy

In Literacy we have been reading the book 'Whatever Next?' by Jill Murphy. We discussed how Baby Bear imagines himself flying the moon in his rocket and the things he decides to take with him. The children then imagined themselves going on a trip to the moon. They discussed what they would like to take with them and wrote a list using their phonic knowledge.

Maths

In Maths we have been learning about odd and even numbers. We started by looking at numicon and how all of the odd numbers have an extra piece on top. We sorted them into odd or even numicon shapes. The children then ordered them from 1 to 10 and noticed that there was an odd, even, odd, even pattern. We then pretended that two teddies wanted a picnic but they wanted an even number of food and nothing left over. The children shared the food evenly between the teddies and discussed how this was an even amount as no food was left over.

Sun Cream

We would be grateful if you could apply sun cream to your child before they come to school in sunnier weather. Please be aware that we are not able to apply sun cream to your child and if they bring in sun cream, they must be confident to do this themselves. Children should also bring in a sun hat and a water bottle. Thank you for your understanding.
