

#### Our learning this week -

We have continued to learn about Space. We watched video clips of the moon landings and discussed similarities and differences between the moon and Earth. In EAD we learned about the technique of marbling using marbling ink. The children made some beautiful patterns with the ink to create planets. We are looking forward to showing these off (along with all of their other creative projects) at the Art Exhibition on the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> of July.

In RE, we have been learning stories about Jesus that show him being a rescuer. We read together the story about Jesus healing the blind beggar. *Literacy* 

In Literacy we have been reading the book 'The Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram. The children loved this book and thought the illustrations were really interesting. The book is all about Bob, who is the man that goes to work every day in his rocket and looks after the moon. The children then wrote some brilliant recounts of Bob's day. We were really impressed with their sentences and the effort they put into their writing!

#### Maths

In Maths we have been learning about addition. The children have been combining two groups of amounts to work out a total. They used the partwhole method and cubes to work out their answers. We have also recapped numbers to 20.
