

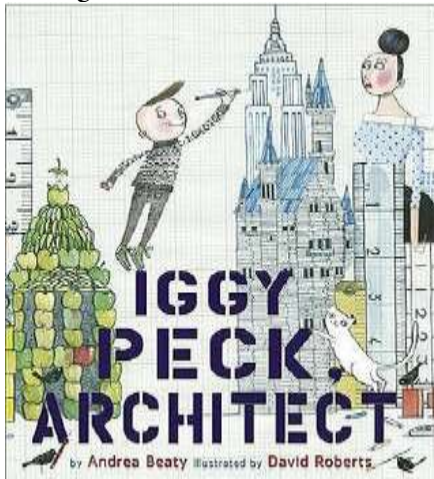


Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 15th July 2022
