<u>English:</u>

This week in English we have continued reading Black Dog and using this to inspire our work in class. The children have been working hard to use contractions correctly, including placing the apostrophe in the right place. They have been using this skill throughout all of their writing this week. They have most recently been focusing on how to use exclamation marks for effect. In the book, the youngest member of the Hope household goes outside to see the enormous, black dog. The children were tasked to write persuasively to stop the child from going any further outside or to convince her to come back into the house. The writing that the class produced was fantastic, they worked incredibly hard to use exciting and dramatic language and end their most dramatic sentences with an exclamation mark.

<u>Maths:</u>

This week, we have recapped time. As a class we have looked at telling the time in 5 minute intervals and to the nearest minute. To finish the week of year 3 looked at calculating how much time had passed from a start point to a finish point.
