This week in English we are continuing with our work on Weslandia. As part of our grammatical focus, we have been looking at **the suffixes, 'OUS' and 'ATION'**. We were learning that when you add the suffix **OUS** to a word, you are changing it from a noun into an adjective. Similarly with the suffix **ATION**, when you add that to a word you are changing the word class from a verb to a noun. We have also been using fronted adverbials to retell the story. Fronted Adverbials are words, phrases or clauses at the beginning of a sentence which are used to describe the action that follows.

This week during Maths we have been revising addition and subtraction. The children have worked so hard on this topic during the year I challenged them with some Year 5 problems.
