Science

This week, the children consolidated their previous electrical knowledge. Electricity is a type of energy that we use to power lots of things around our homes. Electrical energy is caused by electrons (the particles in atoms) that move about to make a current. Electricity can be generated using coal, gas, nuclear fuels, the wind or sunlight. Electricity is transported to our homes, schools and places of work through wires and cables and it may be stored in batteries (sometimes called cells). The children learnt about voltage (the difference in electrical energy between two parts of a circuit) and currents (the amount of electricity flowing through the circuit). The children enjoyed exploring electricity by using batteries (cells that make electricity), wires (often with crocodile clips so they are easy to attach), bulbs, switches (these turn circuits on and off, stopping the electrical current from flowing) and buzzers to create simple series circuits.
