Our learning this week -

This week the children have continued to practice their class Collective Worship. The children are trying really hard to remember their words and to sing loudly and confidently. They have been working very hard and we hope that you can come and see it next week on Wednesday 13th July at 9.00am.

On Thursday, the children spent the afternoon in Year 1 with Mrs Matthews in preparation for September. They had a lovely afternoon getting to know the classroom and their new adults.

Maths

In Maths we have been learning doubling facts. The children have learnt that the term 'double' just means two of the same. To understand the concept of doubles we have been playing dice games and dominoes to recognize doubles. The children can recall doubling facts to 5 and some can recall facts beyond 5. The children then used numicon and a 'doubling machine' to put a number in and work out what it would come out as when it is doubled in the machine.

Phonics

This week in phonics we have started learning about split digraphs. A split digraph is the phoneme made when two vowels are split by a consonant. For example we learnt about the a-e split digraph and found lots of words this was used in such as cake, late, plate and wave.

RE

In RE this week we have been learning the story of Zacchaeus. In the story many people did not like Zacchaeus because they thought he was a bad person. We learned that the message of the story was that Jesus loves and forgives everybody, even if you have done something bad in the past.

Open Evening

On Thursday 14th July it is our open evening. It will run from 3.15pm to 5pm. We look forward to seeing you then.
