Dear Parents and Carers

Oxted School Open Evening Thursday 6 October 2022 (6.00pm to 8.30pm)

You will shortly be faced with making the very important choice of secondary school for your child. As part of your consideration of that decision, we would like to invite you to join us at our Open Evening on Thursday 6 October from 6.00pm to 8.30pm, enabling you to experience a flavour of Oxted School.
