

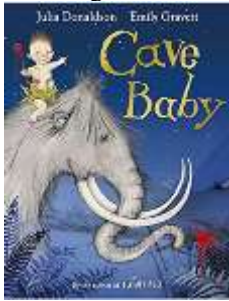


Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 16th September

English

This week we have finished reading 'Cave Baby'. The story, about a naughty boy who lives in a cave, it's about dreams and imagination.



So far we have learnt about adjectives and how to write a noun phrase eg. the funny, hairy hyena. Then we rewrote sentences from the story adding in capital letters and full stops.

We really enjoyed acting out the story in small groups adding in key words and phrases.
