### English

This week in English we started our new book 'The Heart and the Bottle' by Oliver Jeffers. On Monday the children entered the classroom to a strange sight. An abandoned chair, an open book, old, worn-down slippers and discarded glasses. The children then began the week by creating questions based on this scene using question stem words like 'when, why, who and where'. They then used inference skills to answer their own questions, predicting how they think the story will unfold. Later on in the week the children looked at adding the prefixes un-, mis- and dis- to the beginning of root words to change their meaning.

### Maths

This week in Maths we have been looking at place value.

This week the children have learnt to:

- Represent two digit numbers using manipulatives and pictures.
- Partition number up to 100 in different ways.
- Order numbers up to 100 on a number line.
- Represent a three digit number.
