We had a lovely Science lesson this week, where the children had to work in groups to create a fact file on the lifecycle of a human.

### **English**

We have started our new book 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy this week. We found a cloak, scarf and 6-fingered pair of gloves on the school field and wrote investigative questions on what we saw.

#### **Maths**

This week in Maths we have focused on place value of numbers up to 1 million. The children have solved lots of tricky problems!

#### **Wellbeing**

In Wellbeing this week we looked at the terms 'prejudice, equality and stereotypes. The children completed questionnaires to find out who is similar to them in the class and who is different. We also discussed prejudices around gender and asked questions —Can a girl play rugby? Can a boy play with dolls?
