Welcome and introductions were made.

## **Item 1: Large Wooden Play Equipment**

We talked about what we want to do in Pupil Parliament.

We shared our ideas and Miss Woods wrote them down.

We thought about:

Does everyone in school want to raise money for this?

#### **Item 2: Equality**

MIss Woods explained the Equality plan that the Governors are supporting. She also told Pupil Parliament about Year 5's Equality Ambassadors' Research and termly Equality Summits to be held this year.

Pupil Parliament discussed how people feel when they come to the school.

We thought about:

How people from all religious faith backgrounds and who belong to no faith in particular feel

How people from all cultures and races feel

How disabled people might feel - there was an extended discussion about wheel chairs and how children in wheelchairs would be able to join in everything

How people from different family structures may feel - there was an extended discussion amongst the older members about making sure everyone knew it was good to be different.

Lennon suggested we did a poster competition - 'Equal but Different' to represent different people 'to make sure everyone felt welcomed and safe' when they join the school. Miss Woods and the rest of the Parliament thought this was a really good idea. Miss Woods suggested she could advertise it in her Head teacher's newsletter and give a deadline for after half term with posters to be judged by the Parliament and prizes to be given out in Collective worship. The Parliament agreed.

Miss Woods reminded everyone about the Pupils' Peacemakers' Charter. She will check teachers have shared with their classes.

#### **Actions:**

Pupil Parliament will read and check the Peacemakers' Charter at the next meeting.
