This week we have finished our learning around our book called 'The Naughty Bus'. We used the story to innovate upon, inventing the sequel for his adventures. The children used storyboards which they had modelled for them. We called our own version narratives 'The further adventures of Naughty bus'. We thought carefully about remembering to use a capital letter at the beginning of a sentence and a full stop at the end. We were even able to use conjunctions e.g. 'and', 'but'.
