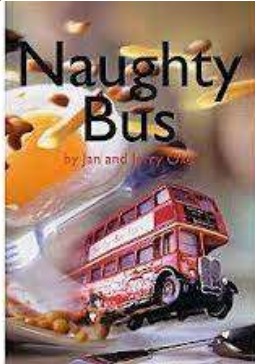




Year 1 Homework Letter-Friday 30th October 2022
