Huge apologies for the lack of homework last week but our photocopier stopped working. I have given an update on our learning this week and included the homework set last week.

<u>English</u>

This week we have begun to write our own version of 'Jim and the Beanstalk'. We planned our story using words and pictures on a 'story S' thinking about our character and the three items that they would buy for the giant. We used this plan to:

- Tell our story to a friend
- Act it out
- begin writing our own story, concentrating on fronted adverbials (different ways to start our sentences) and the use of adjectives (describing words).

<u> Maths</u>

This was our final week learning about place value. by the end of this week we began to learn to count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. Please encourage your child to learn their 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Homework

Homework is in books and based on our English and Maths work. There are spellings in the book and online. There is no reading comprehension this week.
