<u> Year 2 Homework Letter – Fríday 30th September 2022</u>





This week have used fronted adverbials to write paragraphs about the story 'Jim and the Beanstalk'. We used phrases like 'in the morning', 'in the blink of an eye' and after a while' to retell the main events of the story. Also we have been learning what a verb and an adverb are in its simplest form: a verb is an action or a doing word for example clap and adverbs are used to explain HOW that action might be performed – loudly – 'the children *clapped loudly when their team won'. This will* be the basis for this week's homework. Please note we are doing our spelling test in the back of the homework book so you can see how your child is getting on.
