



Year 3 Homework letter - Friday 30th September 2021

Next Wednesday (5th October), the children of Year 3 will be participating in a morning of P.E as part of their wellbeing curriculum. On this day the children will need to have their P.E kit in with them. As the weather is beginning to turn please do remember to pack trousers and jumpers into their P.E kits.

English:

This week in English we have continued to look at our book *'The Heart and the Bottle'* by Oliver Jeffers. Our particular focus this week was on spelling rules for verbs. The children learnt how to add the suffixes -ly to create an adverb and -ness to create a noun

Example:

sad + ly = sadly (A dverb)

sad + ness = sadness (Noun)

Sometimes you have to adjust the spelling of the root word before adding the suffix depending on its ending. If the root word ends in 'y' you have to replace it with an 'i'.

Example:

happy—y + i +ly = happily (A dverb)

happy—y + l + ness =

happiness (Noun)

During our learning we discovered that these rules sometimes don't always apply.

Example: shy + ness = Shyness

Homework

Reading: Please remember to read every evening with your child. Do continue to ask them questions about what they have read to check their understanding.

Reading comprehension: In place of your daily reading please complete the reading comprehension text together. Please note it down in the reading log as normal. Could you please complete the sheet stuck in your homework book entitled *'Planets'*.

Handwriting: Within the children's homework book there is a handwriting sheet. Please follow the examples given working on letter joins and sizing. This is a great opportunity to also memorise the spelling of the words.

- Order numbers to 1000 on a number line.
- To compare numbers to 1000 using < less than and > greater than.
- To order numbers to 1000
- To count in 50s.
