



Year 4 Homework Letter – Friday 7th October 2022

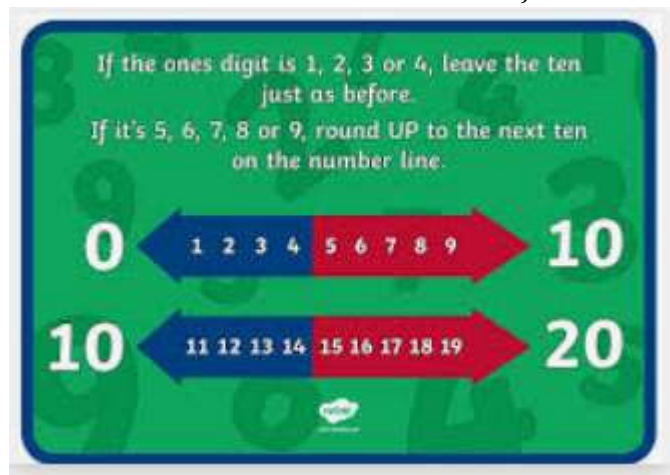
Our Learning This Week

English

In English this week, the children have continued their exploration of 'Gulliver's Travels'. As part of their learning they have written a ship's log in-role as Gulliver writing in the past tense and including the use of expanded noun phrases. The children also designed a poster advertising for the recruitment of sailors for Gulliver's next voyage, as well as making this poster eye catching the children also had to include the use of the four different sentence types: command, statement, exclamation and question.

Maths

This week in Maths, the children ordered numbers up to 10,000 from the smallest to the greatest and the greatest to the smallest. They also use language such as "ascending" and "descending" when putting the numbers in order. We also built on their previous knowledge of Roman numerals from 1 to 12 and learnt that L represents 50 and C represents 100. The children have been learning to round to the nearest 10, the nearest 100 and the nearest 1,000.



Science

In Science this week, we continued to learn about sound and how it travels. The children participated in an experiment in the playground exploring how the human voice gets louder and quieter depending on how near or far away you are from the source. They then learnt about the actual process and completed a detailed diagram of it in their books.

History

In History this week the children continued to learn about Ancient Greece. We explored the idea of democracy and its origins and then moved onto learn about the ideas of different Greek philosophers such as Plato.

R.E

In R.E this week, the children learnt about Mandirs, the Hindu place of worship. They learnt about the building and the rituals observed by Hindus when entering into and worshipping in the Mandir.

Homework

This week's English activity is to learn the spellings for Week 4. For Maths the children must practise their 9 times table and complete the worksheet.
