Our Learning This Week

English

In English this week, the children have continued their exploration of 'Gulliver's Travels'. We have focussed some of learning on our understanding of different noun types including common and proper nouns.



Maths

This week in Maths, children have consolidated their learning, understanding and application of place value as we draw this unit of study to a close. This is to be re-visited later in the academic year. We then proceed to start our learning of our next unit of study 'Area and Measurement'. The children have made a good start learning that area is the space covered by a 2D shape. They have also learnt how to use the strategy of counting the number of squares inside a shape to find its area. We will continue and conclude this short unit of study next week before moving onto addition and subtraction after the half term break.

Love Project -

As part of our 'Love Project' for the Autumn term we are asking families to support Operation Christmas Child. Operation Christmas Child is a project of Samaritan's Purse, a Christian international relief organisation. Through Operation Christmas Child, Samaritan's Purse aims to provide children affected by war, poverty, natural disaster or famine with shoeboxes filled with small toys, hygiene items, and school supplies. This year, in conjunction with Christ Church, we have provided each class with five Operation Christmas Child shoe boxes. We are asking for children to bring in a couple of items suitable for boys or girls between the ages of 5 and 9 to fill these boxes.
