



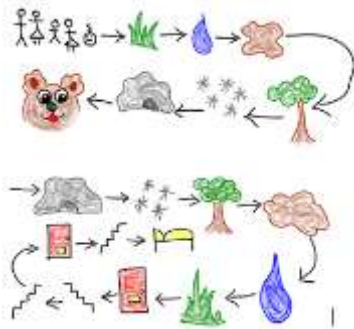
Year R Homework Letter - Friday 7th October

Phonics

This week we have learnt the phonemes: ck, e, u and r. Additionally we have also learnt the following harder to read and write words: to, go into. Please can you remember to keep your child's reading log and books in their book bag every day. Many Thanks in advance.

Literacy

In Literacy this week, we have continued to use the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' as a focus for our learning, the children have helped to create a story map showing the key moments in sequential order. Please see below the story map the children and I created; you might like to ask your child to re-tell you the story using the map as a guide.



In addition to creating a story map, we looked at the setting of the story and then used innovation to change this setting. We had some lovely ideas such as going on a lion hunt in the jungle, a ghost hunt in a spooky house and an alien hunt in space.

Flashcards - we have put more phoneme and harder to read and spell words in your child's bag. Please cut up into flashcards and practise when you can.
