## Phonics

This week we have learnt the phonemes: g, o, c, k. Additionally we have also learnt the following harder to read and write words: put, of, is.

The children have been working really hard to read and write their phonemes. We have also started to blend phonemes together to read and write words such as: dog, cat, mat and cap

## Literacy

We're going on a bear hunt, we're going to catch a big one. What a beautiful day! We're not scared! This week we have been reading 'We're going on a bear hunt' by Michael Rosen. On Monday, armed with binoculars and wellie boots the whole class went on hunt for the class bear, Buddy, who had got lost after playing hide and seek in the school grounds. Luckily he was found safe and well in the bird hide. While trying to find Buddy, we had to travel thorugh long, wavy grass, a deep cold river, thick oozy mud and a big, dark forest! Back in class we set up a 'small world' bear hunt scene with mud, water beads, grass and snow for the children to retell the story. In our focused groups we have been looking at re-telling the story through pictures and trying to identify and write the initial sounds of each setting such as 'g' for grass and 'm' for mud.
