Maths

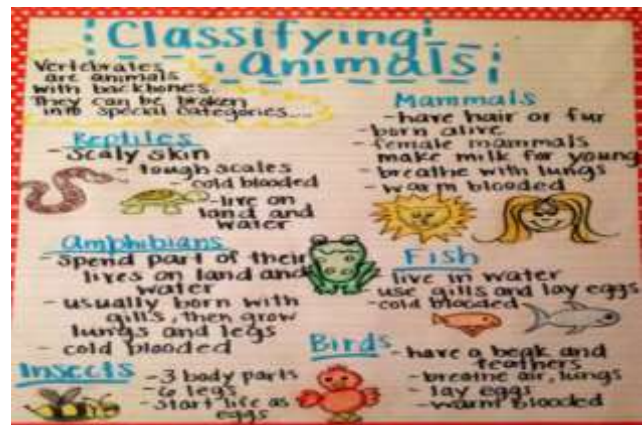
