

Year 2 Homework Letter - Friday 4th November 2022



<u>English</u>

This week we have begun a new book called 'The Journey Home'. It is a beautifully written and illustrated story which deals with the topical subject of climate change and animal extinction. The outcome for this book is for the children to learn about vulnerable animals and to write their own version of the story.
