- Made a wanted poster to stop the hunters and the poachers

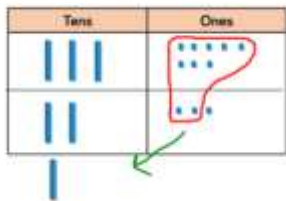


### Maths

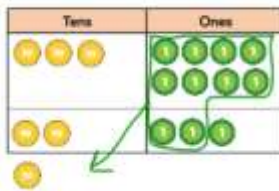
This week we have been learning:

- Adding two 2 digit numbers (crossing and not crossing tens)
- Subtracting two 2 digit numbers (crossing and not crossing tens)

I have included the adding and subtracting guidance. The key objective is for the children to be able to identify how many tens and ones in each number, to partition and then recognise when there are 2 many tens for the ones column (when necessary) and carry them over. It is preparing children for the column method which they learn in Year 3.
