



Year 3 Homework letter - Friday 11th November 2022

English:

The children have loved reading more of the 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl. They have been using a thesaurus to find synonyms for words to make their writing more exciting. We have also been focusing on inferring information from a text regarding a character's emotions. They have all worked hard to create a diary entry from Sophie's perspective while she was being carried in the BFG's pocket.

Maths:

This week, we have started our three week unit on multiplication and division. Over the next two weeks we will particular be focusing on our 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times table. This week we have looked at:

- Sharing into equal groups
- Using arrays to solve problems
- Multiples of 2
- Multiples of 5 and 10
- Sharing and grouping numbers correctly.

Multiplications:

This year, the children will be focusing on learning and using their times tables during our Mental Maths sessions every day. They will be learning their 3, 4 and 8 times tables by using Times Tables Rock Stars, playing games, dancing to 'Supermovers' songs and completing quizzes to help them understand and use this knowledge.
