



<u>Year 4 Homework Letter - Friday 11th November 2022</u>

Our Learning This Week

<u>English</u>

In English this week, the children have continued to explore our new text for this half term FArTHER by Grahame Baker Smith. The children created story maps to enable them to retell the story effectively and convey detailed information about it in a coherent manner. We then moved on to write a diary entry in-role as the Father with the aim of conveying his thoughts and feelings through our writing. The children spent time embedding their understanding of how to write multi clause sentences using co-ordinating conjunctions to write compound sentences. The children ended the week designing their own flying machines and writing an explanation text about their ideas.

<u>Maths</u>

In Year 3, the children used the formal written method to subtract two 2- or 3-digit numbers with up to two exchanges. This week that learning has been extended to include 4-digit numbers. The children have been subtracting up to a 4-digit number from a 4-digit number with no exchanges, using concrete resources as well as the formal written method. Building on this step, the children subtracted up to 4-digit numbers, with one exchange and then moving on to subtracting up to 4-digit numbers, with more than one exchange. I have been really impressed by the children's positive attitude towards this challenging aspects of maths and for the progress they have all made.

As part of our 'Love Project' for the Autumn term we asked families to support Operation Christmas Child.
