

<u>Year R Homework Letter - Friday 18th November</u>

Phonics

This week we have learnt the phonemes: y, z, zz, qu, ch. Additionally we have also learnt the following 'harder to read and write words': we, be, me.

Jack and the Beanstalk

On Monday morning the children entered the classroom to find a treasure chest of gold coins, a golden egg, some large feet, vines and harp music playing in the background. We wondered what might have happened. Mrs Brooks thought she would check the school's security camera and found footage of an enormous beanstalk growing in the school grounds. Luckily our premises manager, Mr Kolndreu, managed to chop it down before the children came to school, as we didn't want anyone climbing it! We thought the story reminded us of the fairytale 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and we remembered how Jack had climbed the beanstalk and found a castle with a giant living in it at the top. This week in our enhanced provision the children have taken part in lots of activities based around this fairytale. They have painted and labelled magic beans, made castles in the clouds using lego and shaving foam, and used beans to measure the height of different characters in the story.

The children also went on a treasure hunt, whereby they had to follow the pictures and read the preposition to take them to the next clue until they found their treasure.
